COMPLAINANTS' MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE IMMEDIATELY

MOTION

Georgia-Pacific, West, Inc. ("GP") and Bellingham Cold Storage Company ("BCS") hereby move for an order immediately suspending the procedural schedule herein, pending completion of negotiations between Complainants and Respondent.

DISCUSSION

By order issued July 31, 2000, the Commission ordered Complainants and PSE "to enter or continue good faith negotiations." Complainants are prepared to do so. In the meantime, PSE Vice President William Gaines, by letter to the parties dated August 1, 2000, has invited mediated negotiations to continue. See attached letter. Complainants desire to accept the invitation.

Under the circumstances, with both parties willing to proceed forthwith, and it being apparent that the full energies of the parties will be necessary to resolve differences between them, it seems logical to suggest a complete focus on negotiations rather than case-building. Such a suspension will save immediate effort and energies and will best serve the public interest by encouraging settlement.
