## **SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE** (January 10, 2002 at 1:30 p.m.)

## TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD:

The Commission has previously set a prehearing conference for Thursday afternoon to attend to process issues in preparation for Monday's hearing on the interim rate request. This notice is to clarify process matters in preparation for the conference.

We will have several tasks to accomplish:

- We will establish the order of witnesses and ask for estimates of time on cross examination. We expect that witnesses having filed direct and rebuttal testimony will present both in one stint on the witness stand.
- We will be assigning exhibit numbers to all documents that are proposed for admission. We ask that all documents that may be proffered during cross examination, other than those arising from the rebuttal testimony filed on Thursday, be provided at the prehearing conference so they may be marked. Any potential exhibits relating to rebuttal testimony should be provided prior to the start of Monday's hearing session unless good cause exists for a delay. Exhibits should be distributed as a single packet by each party, and organized in the order in which the party expects to introduce them. Documents that are submitted and marked but not referenced in the examination will not become part of the record.
- We will hear objections, if any, to prefiled exhibits (except those exhibits received on Thursday morning as to which counsel are not prepared to argue). Any such objections will be heard on Monday.
- Prehearing briefs may be faxed to the Commission for receipt on Friday per the prior schedule.

In addition, any other procedural matters relating to the hearing session may be presented at the conference.
