



RESOLUTION NO. 31

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DECLARING THE OFFICIAL INCORPORATION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE.

WHEREAS, more than 200 years ago, the settlers of America banded together to provide protection and services for the good of all by sharing their visions and combining their skills, resources, and talents to create a community they call home; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 1992, an election was held in northeast King County where the people chose to form a new City called Woodinville, Washington; and

WHEREAS, this community has always been famous for its rolling hills, unspoiled pastoral scenes, fine wines, and beautiful flowers; and

WHEREAS, on November 3, 1992, democracy was celebrated once again when the citizens elected the charter members of their first City Council; and

WHEREAS, as community leaders we will be guiding our new City of 8,650 people; and

WHEREAS, by previous resolution the City Council established March 31, 1993, at 12:00 a.m. as the official incorporation date; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby declares the City of Woodinville officially incorporated as of March 31, 1993, as the 270th incorporated city in the State of Washington.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Woodinville hereby pledges its commitment to maintain the quality of life and community spirit we all enjoy and extends its wishes for a bright and prosperous future for each and every resident of our City.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of Woodinville further invites all citizens to join in the celebration and birth of our new City.
