## NOTICE REVISING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE (Response Testimony and Exhibits now due by June 28, 2019)

Re: In the Matter of the Application of Superior Waste & Recycle LLC For Authority to Operate as a Solid Waste Collection Company in Washington, Docket TG-181023

TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 13, 2018, Superior Waste & Recycle LLC filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application for authority to operate as a solid waste collection company in Washington (Application). On February 20, 2019, Waste Management of Washington, Inc., d/b/a Brem-Air Disposal filed a protest to the Application.

On April 8, 2019, the Commission convened a prehearing conference in this docket and adopted an agreed procedural schedule. On April 9, 2019, the Commission entered Order 01; Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing, which established a procedural schedule that included deadlines for filing testimony and exhibits.

On June 14, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that Staff's witness is unavailable to file response testimony by the June 14 deadline due to medical issues. In light of these unforeseen circumstances, the parties agreed to extend the deadline for filing response testimony and exhibits until June 28, 2019.

Based the parties' agreement and the unavailability of Staff's witness, the Commission finds good cause to revise the procedural schedule to extend the deadline for all parties to file response testimony and exhibits.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the procedural schedule in Docket TG-181023 is revised to extend the deadline for all parties to file response testimony and exhibits until June 28, 2019.
