**NOTICE OF AMENDED ORDER 05**

RE: *In the Matter of the Petition of Puget Sound Energy for an Order Approving Proposed Request for Proposals,*  
Docket UE-200413

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 4, 2020, Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a draft Request for Proposal (RFP) Regarding All Resources in Docket UE-200414, and a draft RFP Regarding Demand Response Programs in Docket UE-200413.

On October 15, 2020, the Commission issued Order 04 in Dockets UE-200413 and UE-200414, granting the Motion for Withdrawal and extending the exemption from WAC 480-107-015(3)(b) until March 31, 2021, subject to conditions, including a requirement that PSE must submit proposed all-source and system wide electric demand response program delivery RFPs and accompanying documentation no later than April 1, 2020.

On March 15, 2021, PSE filed a petition requesting that the Commission extend the deadline for PSE to file its RFPs for demand response resources to November 15, 2021.

On March 25, 2021, the Commission entered Order 05, Granting Petition to Extend Filing Deadline (Order 05), which extended the deadline for PSE's demand response resource RFPs to November 15, 2021. However, Order 05 contained a ministerial error that resulted in contradictory language about whether the Company should file the RFPs in Docket UE-200413 or a new docket. To clarify, the RFPs should be filed in a new docket. Accordingly, pursuant to

WAC 480-07-875(2),<sup>1</sup> the Commission hereby corrects paragraph 10 of Order 05 to the following:

10 We agree with Staff's recommendation and grant PSE's Petition with the expectation that the Company will fulfill the commitments outlined in its Petition. PSE's Petition specifies that the Company will file its draft DER-targeted RFP by November 15, 2021, in this docket. However, we direct the Company to make this filing in a new docket.<sup>2</sup> This decision is consistent with our direction in Order 04 requiring PSE to file the draft RFPs to new dockets,<sup>3</sup> and we reiterate that same direction for the draft RFP to be filed in November. To clarify, the adjustment of the scope and due date of the draft DER-targeted RFP does not alter our approval of the IE to provide its services for both the all-source RFP and the DER-targeted RFP, as was discussed and approved in that petition and order in Docket UE-210037. We expect both RFP processes to benefit from the IE's involvement.

Amended Order 05 is attached to this notice.
