.....)	SEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ACCEPTING TARIFF AMENDMENTS

BACKGROUND

On August 18, 1998, the Commission entered the *Fifth Supplemental Order; Commission Decision and Order* (5TH ORDER), a final Order, in this matter. At Order paragraph 2, the Commission required U S WEST to "file amendments to its tariff clarifying that customers are not responsible for providing the Company with access to a trench or for providing conduit in situations where the Company's facilities need to be repaired, replaced, or maintained." On September 23, 1998, the Commission entered the *Sixth Supplemental Order Granting Reconsideration in Part* (6TH ORDER) in this matter, reiterating at Order paragraph 2 the above from the 5TH ORDER.

MEMORANDUM

On November 25, 1998, U S WEST filed its Advice No. 2993T, purporting to comply with the Commission's 5TH and 6TH ORDERS in this matter. Thereafter, on December 4, 1998, U S WEST filed substitute pages under the same Advice No. 2993T. The Company represents that it has worked closely with Commission Staff in filing amendments to its tariffs as required by the Commission.

Commission Staff has reviewed U S WEST's November 25 and December 4 tariff filings addressing maintenance and repair of facilities and support structure for installed service in the following sections of U S WEST's tariffs: maintenance and repair; service to buildings; and new construction, both inside and outside the base rate area. Staff believes the tariff amendments fully comply with the Commission's 5TH AND 6TH ORDERS in this proceeding and should be accepted.


ORDER
