PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power and Light Company (PacifiCorp) submitted comments in Docket UE-190652 regarding the Energy Independence Act (EIA) rules on May 1, 2020 – as directed by the Notice of Opportunity to Comment distributed March 27, 2020.

PacifiCorp would like to modify the portion of the May 1 comments addressing the inclusion of the definition of CO2 equivalent (CO2e) in the EIA rules as follows:

PacifiCorp does not have any concerns with the inclusion of the definition of CO2e as proposed in the draft EIA rules, and respectfully asks that the Commission not consider the portions of PacifiCorp's comments requesting clarification on the inclusion of CO2e into utility planning processes at this time. PacifiCorp may re-file the planning portions of the CO2e comments in a subsequent Clean Energy Transformation Act rulemaking as appropriate.
