Boomerang Wireless, LLC (“Boomerang” or the “Company”) d/b/a enTouch Wireless has entered into an agreement with Budget Wireless d/b/a Budget Mobile (“Budget”) to transfer some of Budget’s customers to Boomerang. Prior to the transfer of these customers, we wanted to provide this courtesy notice to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.

Boomerang provides prepaid wireless services to customers in twenty-four states, including Washington. We currently serve over 100,000 Lifeline customers nationwide.

Boomerang will become the Lifeline carrier for some of Budget’s customers in Washington on or about September 1, 2016. All transferred customers will continue to receive local and long distance wireless Lifeline services and will retain their same phone and phone number that will operate on the same network.

Each Lifeline customer’s no-cost monthly service plan will be upgraded to include 500 voice minutes + 10 MB of data. There will be no changes to the Terms and Conditions of Service provided to these customers post-transfer.

To ensure a seamless transition and avoid customer confusion or inconvenience Boomerang and Budget will provide affected customers with written notice at least thirty (30) days prior to the transfer. A sample of this customer notice is attached.

Boomerang looks forward to serving these new customers and will work closely with Budget to ensure that all affected customers will experience a seamless transition.
