## **INTERESTED PERSONS:**

On April 28, 1997, TCI Cablevision of Washington, Inc. filed a petition to Adopt Rules, Regulations and Procedures Regarding Attachments to Transmission facilities. On August 27, 1997, the Commission filed with the Code Reviser a Preproposal Statement of Inquiry (CR-101), Docket No. UT-970723, noticing its intention to explore the need to address through rule making, adoption of a methodology for determination of just and reasonable rates for attachments to transmission facilities.

This rule proposal has been delayed pending final action in a similar rulemaking before the FCC in Docket Nos. 97-151 and 97-98. The FCC dockets are still active and pending.

On October 11, 1999, AT&T, the successor in interest to TCI, filed a request with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to defer further activity in docket.

The Commission grants AT&T's request. Procedurally, the Commission will close Docket No. UT-970723. Parties may file another petition when they believe that matter may be productively addressed at the state level.
