Qwest's Response to AT&T's Motion to Strike Certain Qwest Filings

Dear Ms. Washburn:

Qwest and AT&T have discussed AT&T's Motion to Strike and Qwest believes that the parties have reached a resolution of the issues, as discussed below.

AT&T claims in its motion that Qwest's errata filing improperly added new routes and made changes to masked carrier information in a way that prejudices AT&T. Qwest believes that Ms. Torrence's errata testimony is a legitimate and permissible errata, mostly correcting typographical errors, and should not be stricken. However, Qwest understands that the correction of typographical errors in the masked carrier information will prompt AT&T to do additional discovery, and that AT&T will not have responses to that discovery in time for filing testimony on February 2, 2004. Qwest believes, and AT&T agrees, that it will make as complete a filing as it can on February 2. If AT&T needs to file supplemental testimony, on or before February 20, to include information produced in discovery that was prompted by the errata, Qwest would not object to such a filing as untimely. In addition, for any AT&T discovery sent to Qwest on the errata filing by today, January 29, 2004, Qwest will respond to that discovery by February 16.

Owest will appear at the conference tomorrow via telephone.
