RE: Transmittal of Shuttle Express Tariff No 11 Revision

Dear Mr. King:

Shuttle Express requests approval of the submitted Tariff No. 11 revision with an effective date of December 18, 2017. The only revision is to the language in 1) d) describing alternate means of transport.

The recent Final Order in TC-143691 (Order 20), TC-160516 (Order 13), and TC-161257 (Order 10) states that this revision must be submitted to Staff within 30 days of November 17th, 2017.

Additionally, the above orders required submission of a commission agreement to be filed and approved by the commission. As Shuttle Express has opted to discontinue its commission program for all regulated activity with the hotels at this time, we believe no filing is needed. Should Shuttle Express decide to renew the program at a later date, it will submit a proposed form to the commission for approval prior to beginning a commission payment system with hotel staff.
