RE: Rulemaking to consider amending and adopting rules in WAC 480-123, universal service, to implement legislation establishing a state universal communications service program; Docket UT-131239

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

This letter informs you of the progress made in this rulemaking docket concerning the possible adoption of proposed revisions to WAC 480-123, Universal Service, to implement the provisions of Second Engrossed Second Substitute House Bill (2E2SHB 1971), enacted in the 2013 Second Special Legislative Session. Section 204 of the bill requires the commission to establish rules to implement a state universal communications service program. This letter also provides notice of an opportunity to file written comments on the proposed rule amendments and to participate in the formal rule adoption hearing scheduled for 1:30 p.m. on Thursday, May 15, 2014.

On April 2, 2014, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (CR-102) with the Office of the Code Reviser. The proposed rules would implement conditions for Commission oversight of the state universal communications program including, but not limited to, criteria for determining eligibility and information requirements, determining funding levels, and operation of an Advisory Board. The Commission has reviewed comments received from stakeholders received to date in this docket and has prepared proposed rules for review and comment by interested persons. The proposed rules are available for inspection on the Commission's web page at <u>www.utc.wa.gov/131239</u>. to you, please contact the Commission's Records Center at (360) 664-1234. The CR-102 filing initiates the final part of the rulemaking process, which includes a written comment period, a public adoption hearing, and a decision by the Commission.
