NOTICE CANCELLING JOINT WORKSHOP ON OCTOBER 4, 2021

Re: Relating to Electricity Markets and Compliance with the Clean Energy Transformation Act, Docket UE-210183

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On April 5, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed with the Code Reviser a Preproposal Statement of Inquiry (CR-101) to promulgate new rules to implement certain sections of the Clean Energy Transformation Act (CETA)¹ centered on the implementation of Chapter 19.405 RCW. The Commission filed the CR-101 under Docket UE-210183. The Commission is jointly working with the Department of Commerce (Commerce) on this rulemaking.

On July 14, 2021, the Commission issued a Notice of Joint Workshops which set the dates for three joint workshops. The Commission provides notice that the workshop previously scheduled for Monday, Oct. 4, 2021, is cancelled.

The workshop scheduled for 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. on Monday, Sept. 27 will discuss issues related to double-counting of non-energy attributes.
