## Joint Applicants Data Request No. 124

On page 10 of Ms. Alexander's testimony, she states "nor can it be said that [Spinco's post-closing operating] systems will be the same as those currently in place." Please identify each way in which the operating system will not be the same as those currently in place, and the bases for that identification.

### **RESPONSE:**

Ms. Alexander's statement reflects her understanding that Verizon's systems are not the same as the systems currently used by Frontier in other states because Frontier's systems are proprietary to its own operating systems and Verizon's systems in Washington are those that were transferred from its former GTE companies, as updated by Verizon since that transfer. Ms. Alexander has not evaluated the details of either system.
