Westgate Communications LLC d/b/a WeavTel's five year service quality plan.

Westgate Communications LLC dba WeavTel ("WeavTel") submits initial five-year build-out Service Quality Improvement plan pursuant to C.F.R §54.202(a)(1)(ii) that specifies specificity proposed improvements or upgrades to the WeavTel's network throughout its service area, In addition, WeavTel is providing information that includes an estimate of the population that will be serviced as a result of these improvements. The receipt of USF support, combined with other funding sources will allow WeavTel to continue to meet its broadband obligations within its service area, complete service request within a reasonable amount of time.

2015: 1st year

WeavTel will continue its build out, increasing its service area and broadband capabilities. This will include applying for and receiving Right of Way permits to build two 100 foot communications towers for the Stehekin exchange/wirecenter. The planned site for the first fixed wireless tower (that is included in the cost study for USF purposes) tower will be behind the current central office/earth station in Stehekin, off of Stehekin Valley road adjacent to the Stehekin Waste Water treatment site. The second tower is planned to be built behind the National Parks Services Shops off of Company Creek Road approximately five miles up from the mouth of the Stehekin River. In combination the two towers will cover approximately 15 square miles. These two towers will have the potential to increase telephone lines in the area by over 30 lines and 30 broadband subscribers. This is a 30% increase in telephone line count and 300 percent increase in broadband services. The projected capital expenditures for this year are \$30,000.00.

2016: 2nd year

Upon completion of the two towers, WeavTel will then be able to move to procure right of way permits to place radio repeater at Grouse Mountain or Junior Point located at 48 degrees 1 minutes 58.17 seconds north 120 degrees 22 minutes 12.07 seconds West, as well as obtaining colocation contract to place radio repeater on Chelan butte at coordinates 47° 48' 25.69" North 120° 2' 2.23" West. Construction of the two repeater sites will be initialized as seasonal access to the region allows. The two radio repeater sites will permit terrestrial connectivity/backhaul from the Stehekin Exchange back to its tandem, improving service by enabling WeavTel to provide exponentially greater bandwidth to customers. The projected capital expenditures for this year are \$25,000.00 in engineering and permitting process. These expenditures will allow the next year build out.

2017: 3rd year

Construction of the two radio repeater sites at the two sites will conclude, after which terrestrial backhaul connectivity to the Stehekin Exchange will be setup and implemented. Upon completion, internet bandwidth in the exchange will be increased upwards of 500%. Other improvements to service include Sun outages will not be able to affect telephone service. Additionally, WeavTel will be able to provide high speed internet to all customers at a

reasonable price. With this build out, the Stehekin exchange will no longer be disconnected from the contiguous lower forty eight states. The projected capital expenditures will be \$40,000.00.

2018: 4th year

WeavTel's fourth year plan includes placing and installing additional small communications tower(s) around the Stehekin Valley to cover any non-serviced (Dead spaces) that cannot be reached by the main two towers. This will improve service by providing connectivity availability fully to the Stehekin area. This will increase telephone lines by 15 lines and 10 broadband subscribers. The projected capital expenditures for this year are \$18,000.00.

2019: 5th year

Subsequent to the supplementation of service to dead spaces within the Stehekin Valley, WeavTel will initiate expansion of service provision along the lakeside between the communities of Lucerne and Stehekin through the installation of additional small communications tower(s) as needed. This will improve service by providing connectivity availability along the Lucerne/Stehekin lakeside. This will increase telephone lines by 10 and broadband subscribers by 15. The projected capital expenditures will be \$23,000.00
