Covad Communications Company files these comments in support of standardized discovery that will allow the parties to focus on the substantive issues in this proceeding rather than on discovery disputes. To this end, Covad supports adoption of the template discovery questions prepared by the NARUC Triennial Review Implementation Project ("TRIP") task force made available at the prehearing conference, subject to necessary modification to take into account Washington-specific law and facts.

Covad's only specific change to the TRIP template discovery pertains to Question 1a on page 12 of the section regarding discovery to ILECs in the 9-month case. Covad proposes to modify that question by adding the underlined language as follows:

Please state whether the process is mechanized or manual. If the process is mechanized, please state whether the service orders flow through. If the service orders do flow through, please state whether the entire process occurs without any manual intervention. If orders do flow through, please state the percentage of the service orders that flow through to completion.

This change will help clarify the process being described. Covad additionally requests clarification of whether parties will be allowed to conduct follow-up discovery, if warranted.



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Covad supports the proposed TRIP template protective order, subject to necessary modification to take into account Washington-specific law and facts. Covad also requests clarification whether the references to "days" in the template TRIP protective order refers to calendar or business days.
