As you are aware, on June 14, 2021, the Commission entered Order 05, classifying Concrete and More as a solid waste carrier, ordering the company to cease and desist, and imposing penalties in the amount of \$2,000. The Commission sent the company a Final Notice dated July 28, 2021, indicating that the balance of \$2,000 was due.

This is to notify you that the Commission may forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. In that event, you will likely incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees and interest, which would be added to your outstanding \$2,000 balance.
