SCHEDULE 102

FIXED-INCOME SENIOR & DISABLED RESIDENTIAL SERVICE - WASHINGTON

AVAILABLE:

To Customers in the State of Washington who are qualified and selected by Spokane Neighborhood Action Programs ("SNAP") or Rural Resources Community Action ("Rural Resources"). The total number of participants in this pilot for Schedule 2 (electric) and Schedule 102 (natural gas) are limited to 800 (700 for SNAP and 100 for Rural Resources).

In order to be qualified for inclusion in the pilot by SNAP or Rural Resources, a participant must have a household income between 126-200 percent of the Federal Poverty Level and on a fixed income.

Intake and customer selection will primarily occur in the first year and selected customers will remain on this Schedule through the end of the pilot's term.

TERM:

The pilot will run from October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2017.

MONTHLY RATE:

The Monthly base rate shall be the same as that contained in the currently effective Schedule 101 of this tariff.

In addition, customers taking service on this schedule will receive the discount credit set forth in tariff Schedule 189.

Similar to Schedule 1, the above Monthly Rate is subject to the provisions of Tax Adjustment Schedule 58, Purchased Gas Cost Adjustment Schedule 150, Gas Rate Adjustment Schedule 155, Demand Side Management Adjustment Schedule 191, Low Income Rate Assistance Adjustment Schedule 192, and Decoupling Mechanism Schedule 199.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Service under this schedule is subject to the Rules and Regulations contained in this tariff. Customers served at gas pressures exceeding two pounds per square inch will be required to execute a special contract for service.

LOW INCOME RATE ASSISTANCE RATE ADJUSTMENT- WASHINGTON

APPLICABLE:

To Customers in the State of Washington where the Company has natural gas service available. This Low Income Rate Assistance Rate Adjustment or Rate Adjustment shall be applicable to all retail customers taking service under Schedules 101, 111, 112, 121, 122, 131, 132 and 146. This Rate Adjustment is designed to recover costs incurred by the Company associated with providing Low Income Rate Assistance (LIRAP) to customers.
