NOTICE OF INTENT TO ENTER PROTECTIVE ORDER

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Puget Sound Energy Consolidated Dockets UE-170033 and UG-170034

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 13, 2017, Puget Sound Energy (PSE) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-60, Tariff G, Electric Service, and its currently effective Tariff WN U-2, Natural Gas.

On January 19, 2017, the Commission entered Order 01, Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions; Order of Consolidation. To expedite the parties' ability to conduct discovery, the Commission intends to enter in this proceeding a standard protective order with highly confidential provisions no later than Friday, January 27, 2017.

Any party to this proceeding who wishes to propose additional terms to the Commission's standard protective order must file a written response no later than 5 p.m. on Wednesday, January 25, 2017. The parties, including any who become parties via intervention, will be given an opportunity to propose amendments to the standard form of order during the first prehearing conference.
