Amendment Number: 1

Description of amendment: Amends the agreement reflecting implementation of the FCC's Intercarrier Compensation Reform Timeline as provided in the *USF/ICC Transformation Order FCC 11-161 (rel. November 18, 2011)*.

The amendment amends the interconnection agreement first approved by the Commission on 04/30/2003 (date) in WUTC Docket No. UT-033013 (original docket number).

Company A represents that the amendment does not discriminate against non-party carriers, that it is consistent with state and federal law, and that it is in the public interest. By virtue of Company B's signature on the amendment, Company A believes that Company B agrees with these representations.
