WIC requests that the WUTC commence an adjudicative proceeding and set 5 this application for hearing for the reasons identified in this protest. 16 WIC is an auto transportation company operating under authority issued by the 17 WUTC in Permit C-1073. See Attachment. Under this authority, WIC provides scheduled 18 airport transportation service between Yakima, Ellensburg, and Cle Elum on one hand, and on 19 the other hand the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport and the Seattle Amtrak station. WIC 20 operates and maintains in Washington a fleet of four - 10 passenger vans, sixteen - 20 to 24 21 passenger minibuses, and ten – 40 to 47 passenger motorcoaches used for the transportation of 22 passengers and express service. WIC's address is 1416 Whitehorn St., Ferndale, Washington, 23 98248. 24 WIC believes that a grant of Applicant's application is not in the public interest

and is not required by the public convenience and necessity. Applicant requests authority to

1	provide door-to-door and scheduled service between Seattle and Ellensburg with service to

3	Bellevue, Redmond, Issaquah, North Bend, Snoqualmie Pass, Easton, Cle Elum, intermediate
4	points, and points within one mile of I-90, via I-90, SR-10, SR-906, I-405, and SR-520, which
5	could be interpreted as including Sea-Tac Airport. WIC already provides satisfactory service
6	along the portions of this route within its certificated territory. There is no public need for the
	Applicant's proposed, duplicative service, as WIC's existing equipment is not fully utilized and
7	is available to provide additional service should the need and opportunity arise. WIC also
8	believes that the Applicant is not fit, willing, and able to provide the proposed service in
9	accordance with the applicable laws, rules, and regulations.
10	If the WUTC sets this matter for hearing, WIC will appear, submit evidence, and
11	present witnesses at the hearing in support of this protest. WIC will represent itself in this
12	proceeding and will be represented by its attorneys, Brooks E. Harlow and David L. Rice.
