

**NOTICE
PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY**

Pursuant to Washington Law (including without limitation RCW 80.28.050 and -060) and the Commission's Rules & Regulations, Pacific Power & Light Company has filed with the Commission an original tariff schedule for electric service in the State of Washington.

Overview

The purpose of this filing is to administer a refund of \$212,068, which represents approximately 0.1 percent of annual base revenues, or 1.3 percent of March revenues. This amount represents the Company's portion of a settlement entered into by the Washington Attorney General's Office with various energy trading companies that provides restitution to commercial and industrial consumers who paid higher electricity prices during the energy crisis of 2000-2001.

Unless suspended by the Commission, these tariff sheets will become effective March 1, 2005.
