The docket referenced above is captioned "Application for Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire in the City of Enumclaw" (application for a "Certificated Area") and involves an area where Puget Sound Energy ("PSE" or the "Company") has been granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate a Gas Plant for Hire (PSE's "Certificated Area").

In its application the City of Enumclaw (the "City") stated that the City has a gas main with sufficient supply within 600 feet of the area proposed to be transferred from PSE's service area to the City's service area and that PSE's available service was much farther away.

The Company agrees that the above facts provide a reasonable argument for the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to change the City's Certificated Area and PSE has no objections to this change in the City's and PSE's Certificated Areas.
