TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

This letter is to inform you of the progress made in the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (Commission) rulemaking in Docket TN-080875. In this rulemaking, the Commission is examining the need to remove the annual vehicle fee for non-profit transportation providers from rule and allow the Commission to set the fee by order each year in WAC 480-31-080, relating to non-profit transportation providers. This letter also provides notice of an opportunity to file written comments on the proposed rule and participate in the formal rule adoption hearing.

On July 30, 2008, the Commission filed a notice of proposed rulemaking (CR-102) in this docket with the Code Reviser. The proposal allows the Commission more flexibility in adjusting the fee, either up or down, to meet the intent of RCW 81.66.030, which requires the Commission to charge fees that approximate the cost of regulation. The Commission is not considering any changes to the current fee as a part of this rulemaking. This action begins the final part of the rulemaking process, which includes a written comment period, a public adoption hearing, and a decision by the Commission.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE of your opportunity to submit written comments on the proposed rule by filing with the Commission Executive Director and Secretary either by electronic transmission as described below, or by physical delivery to 1300 S. with the Code Reviser, is available for inspection on the commission's web site at www.utc.wa.gov/080875. The Commission will send you a paper copy of the proposed rule or will send the proposal via electronic mail, if you ask.
