### Recommendation

### **Discussion**

On January 28, 2009, Marbello Water Company, Inc., (Marbello or company), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) tariff revisions that would increase the rate for water usage from \$2.97 per 100 cubic feet to \$3.13 per cubic feet. The change will generate \$1,568 (2.5 percent) in additional annual revenue. Marbello serves 97 customers near the City of Monroe, located in Snohomish County. The filing is prompted by the City of Monroe, from which Marbello purchases its water, raising its rates 5.5 percent for water usage effective January 1, 2009.

Today's presentation allows customers or other parties to make comments to the commission. No action is required by the commission. Staff will make its recommendation to the commission at the open meeting scheduled for February 26, 2009. All customers receive metered service. Marbello's last rate increase became effective in April 2008.

Marbello notified its customers of the rate increase by mail on January 28, 2009. The commission has received no customer comments on this filing as of February 9, 2009.
