- This matter came before the Commission at its open meeting on May 14, 2009. On May 15, 2009, the Commission entered Order 01—Order Granting Temporary Discontinuance of Service; Setting Matter For Hearing.
- STATUTORY AUTHORITY: The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter under RCW Title 81, and has legal authority to regulate persons seeking to furnish commercial ferry service under RCW 81.84 and WAC 480-51. The statutes that apply to this matter include RCW 80.01, RCW 81.04, RCW 81.84, and RCW 34.05, including but not limited to RCW 80.01.040, RCW 34.05.434, RCW 34.05.437, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.443, RCW 81.84.010, and RCW 81.84.060. The rules that apply to this matter include WAC 480-51-130 and WAC 480-51-150.
- The Commission will hear this matter under the Administrative Procedure Act (APA), particularly Part IV of RCW 34.05 relating to adjudications. The provisions of the APA that relate to this proceeding include, but are not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.422, RCW 34.05.431, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW

34.05.452. The Commission will also follow its procedural rules in WAC 480-07 in this proceeding.

NOTICE OF HEARING

The Commission convenes a hearing in this matter to address concerns about whether San Juan's request for a temporary discontinuance of service should be granted, or alternatively, whether the Commission should cancel the Company's certificate or the Company should relinquish its certificate to allow another carrier to provide service.
