Attached for filing with the Commission is an electronic copy of the Company's "revised filing" of its proposed revisions to the following tariff sheet, WN U-29:

Substitute Eleventh Revision Sheet 191 Canceling Revised Eleventh Revision Sheet 191

This filing is a substitute to Avista's request for approval of an increase to Schedule 191 rates filed with the Commission on February 12, 2010. This substitute tariff provides new rates that reflect an agreement with Commission Staff to spread the requested increase spread over 16 months rather than the requested 1 year.

The estimated annual revenue change associated with this filing is approximately \$3.2 million for natural gas Schedule 191, or an increase of 2.27% of billed rates. The proposed rate will have an average monthly bill impact to residential customers using 70 therms of \$1.25.
