RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Master Call Corporation

Staff's Request to Rescind Penalty Assessment Docket UT-130826

Dear Mr. King:

On Aug. 1, 2013, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a \$1,800 Penalty Assessment in Docket UT-130826 against Master Call Corporation for 18 violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-120-382, which requires telecommunications companies to furnish annual reports to the commission no later than May 1 each year.

Since the penalty assessment was issued, it has been discovered that the annual report was incorrectly recorded under Master Call Communications, which is a different company. Master Call Corporation timely filed its 2012 annual report on April 30, 2013. Staff recommends that the assessed penalty be withdrawn and the docket closed.
