Amendment Number: 1

Description of amendment: Amends the agreement to revise the Sub-Loop Unbundling Charges

The amendment amends the interconnection agreement first accepted by the Commission on 1/16/2014 (date) in WUTC Docket No. UT-133021 (current docket number). That agreement was originally approved by the Commission on 5/12/2011 (date) in WUTC Docket No. UT-113005 (original docket number) between Company A and Company C Ionex Communications North, Inc. d/b/a Birch Communications (name of company C).

Company A represents that the amendment does not discriminate against non-party carriers, that it is consistent with state and federal law, and that it is in the public interest. By virtue of Company B's signature on the amendment, Company A believes that Company B agrees with these representations.
