RE: Commodity Credit Adjustment for Murrey's Disposal Co., Inc. G-9.

Dear Mr. King:

Attached please find revised pages for Tariff Number 26, as well as supporting documentation for the commodity credit adjustment.

The commodity credit will not change and will remain at \$.49 per residential customer per month. The multi-family credit will decrease from \$.44 to \$.20 (54.5%) per yard per pickup.

If approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the revised commodity credit will go into effect on March 1, 2016. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(vi), affected customers will receive notification of this change on the billing reflecting the revised rates.
