TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 30, 2017, Chariot Transit, Inc. (Chariot Transit or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application for authority to operate as a charter party and excursion service carrier in Washington (Application) pursuant to Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 81.70 and Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-30.

On May 26, 2017, King County filed with the Commission a Petition for Adjudication Pursuant to RCW 34.05.413 and WAC 480-07-305 (Petition). In its Petition, King County requests the Commission commence an adjudication to determine the scope of services Chariot Transit intends to offer. Specifically, King County seeks clarification regarding Chariot Transit's proposal to "offer employers charter contracts for employee commuting solutions."

The Commission requests that Chariot Transit and Commission staff (Staff) respond to the Petition by Wednesday, June 14, 2017, at 5 p.m. The Company should provide clarification about the services it proposes to offer and specifically address the questions raised in the Petition. Staff should address whether King County may petition for an adjudication of the Application and if so, whether an adjudication is necessary to resolve the issues raised in the Petition.
