RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Centrum*

Staff's Request to Rescind Penalty Assessment TE-170607

Dear Mr. King:

On June 19, 2017, the Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a \$1,000 Penalty Assessment in Docket TE-170607 against Centrum for ten violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC 480-30-071 and 480-30-076), which requires charter and excursion carrier companies to furnish annual reports to the commission no later than May 1 each year.

Centrum submitted a response on June 20, 2017. In Centrum's response, the company indicated that they have never operated their vehicle for commercial use and they are not acting as a charter or excursion carrier. On June 22, 2017, Centrum filed a "Release of Authority for Cancellation" form. This company is no longer an active and regulated company, as such, it is staff's recommendation that the assessed penalty be withdrawn and the docket closed.
