RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. TR-170957

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on September 13, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Eastern Washington Gateway Railroad in the amount of \$100 for violations of WAC 480-62-310, which requires railroad companies to report certain events within 30 minutes of learning of the event's occurrence. Eastern Washington Gateway Railroad did not report a freight train derailment in Mondovi, Washington, which occurred on August 5, 2017, until the following day, and has incurred a penalty of \$100. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated November 9, 2017, indicating that the balance of \$100 was due.

The Commission has not received the \$100 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$100 balance.
