NOTICE CONVERTING INFORMAL
COMPLAINT TO FORMAL COMPLAINT;
CALLING FOR ANSWER; AND
INITIATING ADJUDICATIVE
PROCEEDING

- 1 On October 25, 2017, the Coalition of Eastside Neighborhoods for Sensible Energy (CENSE) contacted the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) to raise issues regarding Puget Sound Energy's (PSE or Company) lack of response to CENSE's repeated requests for data, and refusal to study a Distribution Automation solution to increase reliability in East Bellevue. CENSE would like to explore the Distribution Automation solution as an alternative to the imminent Lake Hills-Phantom Lake Transmission line and has hired a consultant to to analyze its feasibility, but requires system data from PSE to complete the study. CENSE alleges that PSE has failed to respond to the consultant's requests for data.
- 2 The Commission, on its own motion, is converting CENSE's informal complaint to a formal complaint and initiating a proceeding to adjudicate CENSE's claims concerning PSE's responsiveness to data requests.
- 3 **The Commission gives notice that PSE's answer to CENSE'S formal complaint is due Monday, November 20, 2017.**
