The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has completed its review of the revised cost assessment questionnaire for the preliminary draft of the Okanogan County Solid Waste Management Plan (Plan), submitted March 28, 2018.

The cost assessment questionnaire in the 2018-2023 Plan proposes no changes in tip fees at the transfer stations located in Okanogan County. As a result, there will be no rate impact to ratepayers served by regulated solid waste collection companies in Oakonogan County at this time, as reflected in the table below.
