Dear Secretary Johnson:

Enclosed are replacement pages to Solid Waste Tariff No. 8 for Sanitary Service Co, Inc., Docket TG-180488.

Due to the volatility in the recycling markets as a result of China Sword restrictions, were are requesting a waiver from WAC 480-70-351(2). The revised calculation uses the most recent six-month historical period to estimate the recycling commodity credit/debit for the next six months.

The impact of the revised tracker is an increase in the residential recycling commodity rate from a debit of \$0.42 to a debit of \$0.89 per customer, per month and an increase in the multi-family recycling commodity rate from a debit of \$0.25 to a debit of \$0.31 per yard per pickup.

In accordance with WAC 480-70-271(2), to the extent the Commission approves the rates reflecting the recycling commodity price adjustment, affected customers will be notified of this commodity rate increase on their next regularly scheduled billing.
