The State of Washington to Chris Robert Miller, d/b/a Silver Limousine and Silver
Transportation:

**You are commanded to appear before the Washington Utilities and Transportation
Commission at the special proceeding referenced in the attached Order and Notice of
Hearing at 9 a.m., on December 10, 2019, in the Commission’s Richard Hemstad
Hearing Room, 621 Woodland Square Loop SE, Lacey, Washington, and to remain
there until discharged by the Commission, to give testimony and evidence under oath as to
the operations of Silver Limousine and Silver Transportation. Chris Robert Miller shall
appear at the time and place set forth above unless the Executive Director and Secretary of
the Commission, by notice of hearing, specifies a different time and place. This is ordered
pursuant to the subpoena powers granted in RCW 34.05.446, RCW 80.01.060(1) and RCW
81.04.510.**

You are further commanded to bring with you the following documents:

If you seek to avoid further enforcement action by ceasing unpermitted
operations and leaving the industry, you must bring sufficient documentation
or records to demonstrate closure of your charter party and excursion service
carrier business. In the case of those whose entire business involves charter
party and excursion services, those papers might include documentation from
(1) the Secretary of State’s office for dissolution of your business; (2) the
Department of Revenue for cancellation of your business license; (3) your
Internet service provider (or equivalent) showing cancellation of a website or
email account; (4) your telephone provider showing cancellation of your
corporate telephone number; (5) proof of cancellation of your company
advertising; and (6) sales receipts for any company equipment sold in the
process of shutting down and closing. For those companies who will continue
with a business but only close that portion involving charter party and
excursion services, similar documentation (*e.g.*, changed website or
advertising) will prove most helpful to the presiding officer. Should you

choose to apply for a charter party and excursion service carrier certificate in advance of the hearing, and the Commission deems you eligible to receive a temporary permit, you may present that information at the hearing.

In lieu of producing these documents at the proceeding, you may mail a copy of the subpoenaed documents to Jason Hoxit, Compliance Investigator, Transportation Safety, Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, P.O. Box 47250, Olympia, Washington 98504-7250, together with your certification that the items produced are true and correct copies of the subpoenaed documents. If you choose to produce the subpoenaed documents by mailing them rather than producing them at the proceeding, you must still appear at the proceeding and the subpoenaed documents must be received at the Commission before the proceeding or you will not have complied with this subpoena.
