ERRATUM TO PENALTY ASSESSMENT

RE: *In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Fiorito Enterprises, Inc., & Rabanco Companies d/b/a Republic Services of Kent in the Amount of \$1,000, Docket TG-190089*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 11, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a penalty of \$1,000 (Penalty Assessment) against Fiorito Enterprises, Inc. & Rabanco Companies d/b/a Republic Services of Kent for ten violations of Washington Administrative Code 480-70-201. Page five of the Penalty Assessment consists of a form to be returned either with payment, contesting the violation, or requesting mitigation. This form erroneously listed the penalty owed as \$800. This erratum notes and corrects that error by modifying the first option on the form as follows:

1. **Payment of penalty.** I admit that the violations occurred and enclose \$1,000 in payment of the penalty.

3. **Application for mitigation.** I admit the violations, but I believe that the penalty should be reduced for the reasons set out below (if you do not include reasons supporting your application here, your request will be denied):

a) I ask for a hearing to present evidence on the information I provide above to an administrative law judge for a decision

OR b) I ask for a Commission decision based solely on the information I provide above.
