**RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment DG-190625**

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on August 23, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Rios Brick Pavers, LLC in the amount of \$7,000 for violations of RCW 19.122.030(2) for failing to provide the required notice to facility operators through a one-number locator service before excavating. The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated October 9, 2019, indicating that the balance of \$7,000 was due.

To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

**This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection.** You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$7,000 balance.
