PCA manufactures and distributes paper products in the United States, including sheet papers, containerboard and corrugated containers, and market pulp. PCA is Pacific Power & Light Company's ("Pacific Power" or the "Company") largest customer in Washington, purchasing both power and power delivery services at its mill in Wallula, Washington. PCA, appearing through its subsidiary, Boise White Paper, L.L.C ("Boise"), is a party to Pacific Power's current power cost adjustment proceeding, Docket UE-190458, and was a party to the Company's recent pension deferral proceeding, Docket UE-181042, as well as the Company's last general rate case, Docket UE-152253.

PCA has a substantial interest in Pacific Power's petition for an order to defer the costs and benefits associated with repowering the Leaning Juniper wind facility, which the Company filed on September 6, 2019. As Pacific Power's largest customer in Washington, PCA could be substantially and directly affected by the Company's proposed deferral. Thus, PCA
