In accordance with WAC 480-07-370(3), Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”), encloses its Petition for an Accounting Order Authorizing Accounting Treatment of Costs of Liquidated Damages Related to PSE’s Green Direct Program.

PSE has begun receiving liquidated damages under the power purchase agreement that will be used to deliver renewable energy to PSE’s customers that will be taking service under Tariff Schedule 139 “Voluntary Long Term Renewable Energy Purchase Rider”. This accounting petition seeks permission to defer the liquidated damages so that they may be used to benefit Schedule 139 customers.

Please note that portions of the petition and Exhibit A to the petition contain information that is **Confidential pursuant to WAC 480-07-160**. This information is commercially sensitive and would harm PSE, its customers and shareholders and the counter-party, if released. PSE therefore requests that the designated information be treated as confidential under WAC 480-07-160.
