Commission Staff's Recommendation to Withdraw Notice of Intent to Cancel

Dear Mr. Killip:

On January 23, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) served a Notice of Intent to Cancel Certification as a Charter and Excursion Carrier to Durham School Services L.P. (Durham) under Docket 191044 for violations of WAC 480-30-071 and WAC 480-30-076, and Durham was given 30 days from the date of the notice to either come into compliance or request a hearing.

The Commission did not receive a hearing request from Durham, and the company did not come into compliance within 30 days of the date of the notice. A cancellation order, however, was never issued, and the company proceeded to operate under an active permit.

On March 15, 2024, Durham came into compliance to avoid cancellation of their certification. Staff, therefore, recommends the Commission withdraw the Notice of Intent to Cancel, given the circumstances.
