- On February 7, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel Certificate; Notice of Opportunity for Hearing (Notice) in this matter. The Notice informed Blessed Limousine, Inc., (Blessed Limo or Company) that the Commission intended to cancel the Company's certificate for continued failure to comply with Commission rules pertaining to charter and excursion carriers. The Notice gave Blessed Limo the opportunity to request a hearing to contest the factual allegations set out in the Notice.
- 2 On February 26, 2020, Blessed Limo filed with the Commission a request for hearing.
- Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether the violations occurred.
