Dear Mr. Johnson:

On September 22, 2020, Avista Corporation, dba Avista Utilities (Avista or "the Company"), filed proposed revisions to its electric tariff WN U-28, Schedule 70, Rules and Regulations. In its original filing, Avista requested that the proposed tariff modifications become effective for service on November 1, 2020, and on September 28, 2020, the Company filed a request to extend its effective date to December 1, 2020 to allow Commission Staff appropriate time to review the submitted tariffs.

After subsequent conversations with Commission Staff, the Company hereby respectfully requests to extend its requested effective date to December 11, 2020, to again provide adequate time for a comprehensive review of the requested tariff modifications. Avista has included with this filing its revised tariff sheets for Schedule 70, reflecting only a change in the effective date of each sheet.
