**NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING**

RE: *In the Matter of the Investigation of Miracle Man Movers, LLC, for Compliance with WAC 480-15, Docket TV-210128*

*In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment against Miracle Man Movers, LLC, in the Amount of \$100 for violations of WAC 480-15, Docket TV-210129*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On February 22, 2021, regulatory staff (Staff) of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) conducted a routine safety investigation of Miracle Man Movers, LLC, (Miracle Man or Company) and documented 77 violations of Washington Administrative Code 480-15. Based on these violations, Staff proposed the Company receive a “conditional” safety rating.

On March 8, 2021, the Commission issued a Notice of Intent to Cancel Permit as a Household Goods Carrier (Notice) in Docket TV-210128 informing Miracle Man that the Commission will cancel the Company’s household goods permit effective April 26, 2021, unless the Company obtains Commission approval of a safety management plan prior to that date. The Notice required Miracle Man to file a proposed safety management plan by April 1, 2021, and set a brief adjudicative proceeding (BAP) for April 15, 2021.

On March 16, 2021, the Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Miracle Man in Docket TV-210129 in the amount of \$100 for the violations discovered during Staff’s compliance review.

On April 14, 2021, Staff informed the presiding officer that the Company had submitted to Staff a proposed safety management plan. Staff evaluated the proposed plan and determined it is acceptable. As such, Staff recommends the Commission cancel the BAP and enter an order addressing the Company’s safety rating based on the evidence in the record.

Staff also explained that it confirmed that the Company waives its right to a hearing with respect to both dockets. Based on the parties' request to cancel the hearing, as well as Staff's approval of the Company's safety management plan, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the BAP set for April 15, 2021, at 9:30 a.m. and to enter an order based on the evidence in the record.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the brief adjudicative proceeding in Docket TV-210128 set for April 15, 2021, at 9:30 a.m. is canceled.**
