IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR PUGET SOUND ENERGY CUSTOMERS ABOUT CHANGES IN ELECTRIC AND NATURAL GAS RATES

Puget Sound Energy (PSE) recently filed requests with the state Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) to adjust electric and natural gas low income program rates. The requested changes are proposed to be effective on October 1, 2021.

An overall decrease in natural gas rates of 0.29% and an overall increase in electric rates of 0.27% are requested to recover changes in costs for the low income bill assistance program. PSE requested these changes through the existing low income bill assistance mechanism previously approved by the UTC. The mechanism allows PSE to periodically adjust its electric and natural gas rates to reflect changes in actual sales and costs. The proposed adjustments would be reflected in the Electricity charge listed on the electric statement and in the Delivery charge listed on the natural gas statement.

The proposed overall average changes for electric and natural gas customers are as follows:
