

1. The Commission finds good cause to support the request and authorize the proposed changes to become effective with Less Than Statutory Notice on: June 17, 2022.

3. The temporary 0.31% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of March 2022 and April 2022, to be collected from customers as follows:
