NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING

RE: *In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties Against Sabra Transportation Inc., d/b/a Sabra Limo Service; Sabra Limo; Seatac Towncar Inc.; Seattle Town Car Inc., et al.*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On August 7, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) served on Sabra Transportation Inc., d/b/a Sabra Limo Service; Sabra limo; Seatac Towncar Inc., Seattle Town Car Inc.; et al (Sabra Limo or Company) Order 01, Instituting Special Proceeding; Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; Notice of Virtual Hearing (Order 01). Order 01 informed Sabra Limo that the Commission had information from which it believed that the Company has advertised, solicited, offered, or entered into one or more agreements to provide charter party or excursion carrier service within the state of Washington without having first obtained a charter party and excursion service carrier certificate. Order 01 also scheduled a brief adjudicative proceeding for October 5, 2022, at 1:30 p.m.

On October 4, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) filed a Settlement Agreement between Staff and the Company purporting to resolve all of the issues raised by Order 01. Staff also submitted a waiver of hearing on behalf of the Company. Staff requests that the Commission cancel the scheduled brief adjudicative proceeding and decide the matter on a paper record.

The Commission finds good cause to cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding currently set for October 5, 2022, and to decide this matter on a paper record.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the brief adjudicative proceeding set for October 5, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. is cancelled.
