Re: TV-230046 – Issuing Permanent Household Goods Permit - HG070281

Dear Let's Move LLC:

On January 23, 2023, Let's Move LLC, d/b/a Let's Move, filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) to provide residential household goods transportation services in the state of Washington. On October 30, 2023, the Commission approved the application in part and granted Let's Move LLC temporary authority to provide those services.

The Commission has determined that Let's Move LLC's qualifies for permanent household goods carrier authority and approves the application in full. Permit HG070281 issued in the name of Let's Move LLC is enclosed, and the company may operate on a permanent basis.

Let's Move LLC must continue to comply with state laws, Commission rules, and the provisions of Tariff 15-C. Failure to do so will result in Commission enforcement action, up to and including revocation of the company's permit.
