NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING

TO ALL PARTIES:

On July 10, 2023, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) initiated a special proceeding to determine if ITX LLC d/b/a Mile High Van Lines (Mile High Van Lines or Company) has engaged, and continues to engage, in business as a household goods carrier within the state of Washington without possessing the certificate required for such operations. The Commission served on the Company Order 01, Order Instituting Special Proceeding; Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; Notice of Hearing (Order 01) which, among other things, scheduled a brief adjudicative proceeding (BAP) on September 19, 2023.

On August 29, 2023, Commission staff (Staff) informed the presiding administrative law judge by email that the parties reached a settlement in principle. Staff requested that the Commission cancel the scheduled brief adjudicative proceeding.

The Commission finds good cause to cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding currently set for September 19, 2023.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the brief adjudicative proceeding set for September 19, 2023, at 1:30 p.m. is cancelled.
